Section Exemptions Information

- Each PGA Section is allotted two Boys Junior PGA exemptions and two Girls Junior PGA exemptions.
 - Boy Champion & Girl Champion, 2020 Section Junior PGA Championships
 - PGA Section At-Large Bid (1 Girl, 1 Boy)
 - The Section may award this exemption at their discretion (ex: Section Championship Runner-Up, Junior Tour Season Points List, Additional Qualifying Event Champion, etc.)
- Alternates
 - Please ensure to designate a minimum of 2 Boys and 2 Girls as alternates. If your Section's successful qualifiers are unable to compete in the National Championship, we will ask for your alternates to represent the Section.
- Exemption Deadlines
 - All Boys Junior PGA Championship exemptions must be decided by no later than **FRIDAY, JULY 3RD, 2020.**
 - All Girls Junior PGA Championship exemptions must be decided by no later than **FRIDAY, JULY 17TH, 2020.**

Eligibility

- Players MUST be eighteen (18) years of age or younger on the final day of each respective National Championship (Boys: July 16, 2020 – Girls: July 31, 2020).
 - Please be aware of the age restrictions during your Section Championship! A player that will become 19 years of age prior to the end of his or her respective National Championship will not be allowed to compete.
- Players must be amateurs as defined by the USGA and must NOT be full-time college students. A player who has begun his or her college career is NOT eligible.
- All successful qualifiers are identified based on the lowest gross score in the oldest age division.
 - Any player who wishes to qualify for the National Championship must play from the same tees as the oldest age division and pay the same entry fees.
- Additional eligibility guidelines specific to each Section Championship can be made at the discretion of each PGA Section. These additional eligibility guidelines can include items such as Section junior tour membership requirements and player residency restrictions.
