ROADMAP TO BECOMING A PGA PROFESSIONAL

A total of 28 work experience credits must be earned in addition to fulfilling the PGA PGM Program. (One credit per month while eligibly employed full time.) 12 credits are awarded for a four year college degree and six credits for a two year college degree.

Applicants need to purchase and review the five qualifying level courses: Introduction to the PGM and the Golf Profession, PGA History, PGA Constitution, Rules of Golf, and Career Enhancement and pass all of the online quizzes. Before you can register as an associate, you must

have a USGA handicap index of 10 or less, shoot

one 18-hole score in a PAT that is equal to or less

than the PAT target score for 18- holes plus 5

strokes, or pass the 36-hole Player Ability Test

(for example, if the course rating is 72, the target

score for the 36 holes would be 159). You can



Acceptable Progress

- Level 1 must be successfully completed within three years of the Level 1 Start Date
- Level 2 must be successfully completed within three years of the Level 2 Start Date
- Level 3 and election to PGA Membership must be successfully accomplished within nine years of the Level 1 Start Date

Failure to complete Level 1 or 2 within three years of the Level's start date will result in suspension. Failure to exit suspension by the end of two years will result in termination from the PGA PGM Program.
